

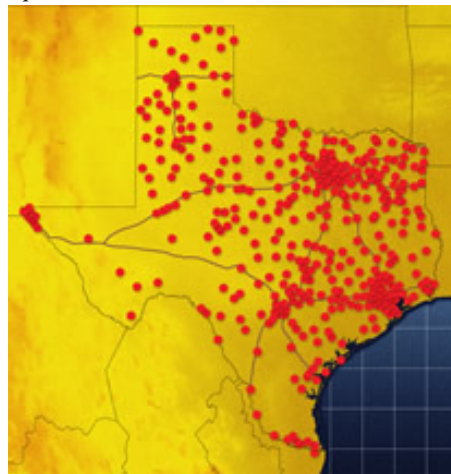
Propane Lawn Mowers



- Propane Lawn Mowers are clean-burning and produce significantly less hydrocarbons than gasoline and diesel lawn mowers. Some models already meet proposed 2012 EPA air standards. Because of Propane Lawn Mowers' GREEN characteristics entities are able to mow on OZONE Action Days.
- Since it is a clean-burning fuel, Propane Lawn Mowers' engines last longer and need less upkeep. Cutting down on maintenance costs.
- The EPA estimates 17 million gallons of fuel, mostly gasoline, are spilled each year while refueling lawn equipment. Propane Lawn Mowers have a closed fueling system so you do NOT spill and contaminate the environment like gasoline and diesel.
- You are just not just saving fuel, your saving money from those lost gallons and typically for fleet lawn mower customers, propane is 20-30 % less than gasoline through fuel contracts.

- Multiple platforms are available from top commercial mower manufacturers

There are over 910 places in Texas where someone can take their propane cylinder to be filled for from rural to large metropolitan areas.



- Propane Lawn Mower Grants are available up to \$2,500 in non-attainment and near non-attainment areas through a state agency's local Clean Cities Coalition with funding from the Propane Education & Research Council (PERC).
